AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 4, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 101.0437 RELATING TO THE M-1 ZONE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1, Division 4, of the San Diego Municipal Code be amended by amending Section 101.0437 to read as follows:

SEC. 101.0437 M-1 ZONE

In an M-1 Zone, no building or premises shall be erected, constructed, converted, established, altered and/or enlarged or used except for one or more of the following uses:

- 1. Any use permitted in Zones R-1, R-2, R-4 and C.
- 2. Aeroplane manufacture.
- 3. Boat and canoe building.
- 4. Building materials storage.
- 5. Bottling works.
- 6. Bakery.
- 7. Blacksmith shop.
- 8. Cabinet making or carpenter shop.
- 9. Carting, express, storage yard.
- 10. Carpet or bag cleaning.
- 11. Central electric plant.
- 12. Cleaning and dyeing works.

Provided, however, that no use shall be permitted in said M-1 Zone which may be so injurious, obnoxious, or offensive to a neighborhood by reason of the emission of odor, dust, smoke, vibration, or noise, as to constitute a public nuisance.

32. On-premises signs constructed, fabricated, erected, installed, attached, fastened, placed, positioned, operated and abated in accordance with the regulations as set forth in Chapter X, Article 1, Division 11, and Chapter IX, Article 5, Division 1, of this Code.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
