AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 3,  
DIVISION 3 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE  
BY AMENDING SECTION 23.0301 [RULE II, SEC-  
TION 1 OF THE RULES OF THE CIVIL SERVICE  
COMMISSION] RELATING TO GENERAL REQUIREMENTS  
FOR APPLICANTS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,  
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 3, Division 3 of the  
San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by  
amending Section 23.0301 to read as follows:

DIVISION 3

APPLICANTS AND APPLICATIONS

SEC. 23.0301 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS  
[Rule II, Section 1 of the Rules  
of the Civil Service Commission]

Unless waived, all applicants must

(1) be citizens of the United States or persons  
lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent  
residence pursuant to Section 1101(a)(20) of the Immigra-  
tion and Nationality Act of 1952, as amended; provided,  
however, that all applicants for peace officer classifica-  
tions shall be citizens of the United States as required  
by state law;

(2) be actual residents of the County of San Diego  
for at least one year immediately preceding the date of  
filing application; provided, however, that this requirement

may be waived by the Commission in order to secure the necessary number of qualified applicants;

(3) meet the minimum requirements stated in the examination announcement;

(4) be able to speak, read, and write English.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.



  - (2) be actual residents of the County of San Diego for at least one year immediately preceding the date of filing application; provided, however, that this requirement may be waived by the Commission in order to secure the necessary number of qualified applicants;
  - (3) meet the minimum requirements stated in the examination announcement;
  - (4) be able to speak, read, and write English.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
