ORDINANCE NO. 11046 MAY 1 1973 (New Series)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 9, DIVISION 3 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 69.0311 RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL APPEALS BOARD.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VI, Article 9, Division 3, of the San Diego Municipal Code be amended by amending Section 69.0311 to read as follows:

SEC. 69.0311 ENVIRONMENTAL APPEALS BOARD

a. There is hereby created an Environmental Appeals
Board which shall consist of seven (7) members who shall
serve without compensation. The members shall be
appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council.
Appointments shall be made for two-year terms with the
initial appointments to include three (3) appointments
for one (1) year each ending March 1, 1974, and four (4)
appointments for two (2) years each ending March 1, 1975.
Each appointee shall serve until his successor is duly
appointed and qualified. Vacancies shall be filled for
the unexpired term of the term of the member whose place
becomes vacant. The Environmental Appeals Board membership
shall include one (1) representative from each of the
following areas: physical sciences, environmental sciences,
social sciences, citizens' groups, private developers, and

two (2) persons not necessarily associated with any of the foregoing areas.

During March of each year the Mayor may designate one member as chairman; however, in the absence of such designation, the Board shall, on or after April 15, select a chairman from among its members.

- b. The Board shall adopt such rules and regulations consistent with law for the government of its business and procedures. The Board shall meet regularly once a month or more often if necessary.
 - c. The Board is charged with the following duties:
 - (1) Reviewing Environmental Impact Reports to determine the sufficiency of such reports when such reports are questioned upon appeal.
 - (2) Rendering advice on procedures for the preparation and review of Environmental Impact Reports and Negative Declarations to appropriate agencies of City government.

In carrying out such duties, the Board shall exercise those powers enumerated in Section 69.0312.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

The Environmental Appeals Board membershy shall include one (1) representative from each of the following areas: physical sciences, environmental sciences, social sciences, citizens groups, private developers, and two (2) persons not necessarily associated with any of the foregoing areas.

b. The Board is charged with the following duties:
