AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 8 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 62.0801, RELATING TO STREET CLOSING FEES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 62.0801 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. 62.0801 STREET CLOSING FEES

(a) Purpose and Policy. The City of San Diego encounters considerable expense in processing applications for street closings. It is the purpose and policy of the Council to establish a fee schedule which shall be paid by the applicant upon the filing of a request for the processing of an application for a street closing in order to reimburse the City for the processing expenses incurred.

(b) The fees shall be as follows:

(1) A fee of \$150.00 for the cost of investigating proposed street closings shall be paid at the time of filing the application for the street closing. This fee is nonrefundable.

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(2) A fee of \$415.00 at the conclusion of the investigation for the costs of all services provided by the City in processing an approved application. Fifty percent of this fee shall be refunded if the City is notified in writing, prior to the ordering of posting of notice and advertising, that the applicant desires to withdraw his application.

(3) Where the applicant requests that a map or plat be prepared by City, an additional fee of \$65.00 shall be paid for each such map or plat. This fee is nonrefundable.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
