AN ORDINANCE CALLING A MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, IN THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, AND IN THE SAN DIEGO COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT, ON TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 18, 1973.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby ordered that a Municipal Primary Election will be held in the City of San Diego on Tuesday, September 18, 1973, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the following offices:

COUNCILMAN - District No. 1	four-year term
COUNCILMAN - District No. 3	four-year term
COUNCILMAN - District No. 5	four-year term
COUNCILMAN - District No. 7	four-year term
CITY ATTORNEY	four-year term

Section 2. It is hereby ordered that a Municipal Primary Election will be held in the San Diego Unified School District on Tuesday, September 18, 1973, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the following offices:

MEMBER BOARD OF EDUCATION - District B	four-year term
MEMBER BOARD OF EDUCATION - District C	four-year term
MEMBER BOARD OF EDUCATION - District D	two-year term

Section 3. It is hereby ordered that a Municipal Primary Election will be held in the San Diego Community College District on Tuesday, September 18, 1973, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the following offices:

Section 6. That the polls for said elections shall be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, September 18, 1973.

Section 7. The City Clerk is hereby directed to procure and supply the required number of ballots, sample ballots, equipment, supplies and other printed matter.

Section 8. The following rates of compensation are hereby established for said election:

For return of each ballot bag	1.00	- each to two precinct board members transporting election packages to collection centers, one way only.


