AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING A PORTION OF LOT 17, RANCHO MISSION, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, INTO R-2 ZONE, AS DEFINED BY SECTION 101.0409 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 7854 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED MAY 1, 1958, OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO INSOFAR AS THE SAME CONFLICTS HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That a portion of Lot 17, Rancho Mission, in the City of San Diego, California, within the boundary of the district designated "R-2" on Zone Map Drawing No. B-2709, filed in the office of the City Clerk under Document No. 744292 be, and it is hereby incorporated into the R-2 Zone, as such zone is described and defined by Section 101.0409 of the San Diego Municipal Code.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 7854 (New Series), adopted May 1, 1958 of the Ordinances of The City of San Diego be, and the same is hereby repealed insofar as it conflicts herewith.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
