That those portions of Lots 13 and 14 of Catalina Three Unit No. 1, Map No. 6413, set aside for future street purposes by the recording of said map, as more particularly described in the legal description attached hereto as Exhibit A, be and the same are hereby dedicated as and for a public street and the same is hereby named MENDOCINO BOULEVARD.

That the City Clerk of said City is hereby authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this resolution in the office of the County Recorder of San Diego County.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF STREET
RESERVATIONS TO BE DEDICATED AND NAMED

MENDOCINO BOULEVARD

All that portion of Lots 13 and 14 of Catalina Three Unit No. 1, according to Map thereof No. 6413 filed July 9, 1969 in the Office of the San Diego County Recorder reserved for future street by said filing of said Map No. 6413, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Southerly line of said Catalina Three Unit No. 1, said point being the Southwesterly corner of said Lot 14; thence North $78^{\circ}11'28''$ West (Record: North $78^{\circ}10'48''$ West per Map No. 6413) along said Southerly line, a distance of 56.00 feet; thence North $11^{\circ}34'58''$ East, 50.43 feet to a point on the Westerly line of Mendocino Boulevard, as dedicated and established on said Map No. 6413, said point being a point of cusp with the arc of a 45.00 foot radius curve, concave Northerly; thence Southerly, Southeasterly and Easterly along the Westerly, Southwesterly and Southerly line of said Mendocino Boulevard and along the arc of said curve through a central angle of $104^{\circ}08'53''$, a distance of 81.79 feet to a point of cusp with a line that bears North $11^{\circ}34'58''$ East to said point; thence South $11^{\circ}34'58''$ West along said line, a distance of 7.01 feet returning to the Southerly line of said Catalina Three Unit No. 1 and the Point of Beginning.
