


RESOLUTION No. 207235

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the bid of \$13,777.00 by T.B. Penick & Sons, Inc., a corporation, for the construction of "J" STREET MINI-PARK in the City of San Diego, California, including the base bid and Additive Alternate "A", is hereby accepted; and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract therefor in accordance with the form on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 742034.
2. That the expenditure of \$19,000.00 is hereby authorized out of the Capital Outlay Fund (Fund 245) of the City of San Diego solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for construction of "J" STREET MINI-PARK in the City of San Diego, and related costs.
