BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

- 1. That Third Avenue between A Street and Broadway be and the same is hereby converted to a two-way street, and that the installation of the necessary signs and markings is hereby authorized.
- 2. That in connection with the above conversion it will be necessary to modify certain traffic signals at Third Avenue and B Street, Third Avenue and C Street and Third Avenue and Broadway, and that therefore the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to do by City forces the necessary work for the modification of said traffic signals pursuant to his recommendation and submission of estimates by him indicating that said work can be done by the City forces more economically than if let by contract.
- 3. That the expenditure of \$4,665 is hereby authorized out of Gas Tax Fund 220 of The City of San Diego, solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for the modification of the traffic signals described above.
- 4. That this change shall be effective when such signs and markings have been installed and traffic signals have been modified.
- 5. That that portion of Resolution No. 140693 adopted July 18, 1957, which established this section of Third Avenue as a one-way street, is hereby rescinded.
