William R. McCullagh	BUILDING INSPECTION	\$875	Mr. McCullagh is a Building Inspection Supervisor. His group of Inspectors are constantly checking construction to see that it conforms to the City's code. Information on details of this work were reported on the Inspector's Daily Work Report as well as in a log book. Extensive changes were made in the system of recording this information and in the form for reporting. The log book is also no longer needed. Nearly \$9000 a year is saved for the thirteen Inspectors involved
Nancy J. Acevedo Catherine J. Rizzo	PERSONNEL DEPARTMENT	\$540	Some time ago this Senior Clerk and Administrative Aide proposed that most leave requests be handled at the department level instead of in Personnel. After study, the Civil Service Commission recommended and the Council approved the necessary changes to the Civil Service Rules as required for adoption of this suggestion. The full time of a Junior Typist has been saved and some of the cost of forms. There is no increase in work at the department level.
Rodman C. T. Burpeau	WATER UTILITIES	\$255	This Utility Foreman II observed that a 30 minute test of water meters at the low flow rate was excessive as accuracy had little effect on water revenue. By a short test to see that low flow rates were registering, over \$2550 in testing cost has been saved, and there is some reduction in meter maintenance for about 14,000 meters a year.
Nancy J. Lovell Carmelinda A. Wood	PUBLIC WORKS Sanitation Division	\$240	These two Intermediate Typists became concerned with conditions in the Division office. They made a proposed rearrangement of facilities and a change of job assignments in the office. The saving from improved efficiency is hard to estimate, but \$2400 a year is reasonable.
