Dear Mr. Sage:

This is to acknowledge the acceptance of the XDS Sigma Three as returned equipment to be utilized as a credit for any amounts owing for the final audit settlement by the City of San Diego Command and Control Program. The return of any equipment is to be based upon the fair market value of such equipment at the time of return and that the amount credited would be based upon the total percentage of participation between the City of San Diego and the California Council on Criminal Justice. The fair market value of the Sigma Three Computer has been set at \$136,185. The total percentage of participation of the City of San Diego in the Command and Control System CCCJ Grant No. 0270 and Discretionary Grant No. 71-DF-549 is 57.48%, thus giving a credit to the City of San Diego of \$78,279.14. This amount is to be applied against any amount owed based upon the final audit of these two grants.
