BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego that the City Manager of The City of San Diego is authorized to submit an application for financial assistance to the Department of Transportation for the purpose of obtaining a fellowship for the City's Planning Director or his representative to attend the Carnegie-Mellon University Professional Program in Urban Transportation, in the form of application on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if the fellowship is approved the City Manager is authorized to accept the grant and execute the required contracts, and make whatever additional applications or arrangements that may be required, all in the form of contracts and applications on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is authorized to use \$6,062 from the General Purpose Revolving Fund 534 for travel and tuition costs, to be reimbursed by the federal government.
