WHEREAS, the new tax imposes a considerable additional burden on citizens, particularly those on fixed incomes, who are presently struggling with inflationary price increases; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of The City of San Diego urges that the sales tax increase be repealed immediately upon reconvening of the California Legislature.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego's legislative delegation be informed of this recommendation.
