RESOLUTION NO. 208660 AUG 21 1973

WHEREAS, SHATTUCK CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, a California corporation, Owner and Permittee, filed an application for a land conservation permit to develop the property located south of Mt. Acapa Drive, between Mt. Carol Drive and Genesee Avenue, more particularly described as a portion of Pueblo Lot 1204, in the R-1-5 (LC Overlay) Zone; and

WHEREAS, on July 2, 1973, the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego made its findings of fact and filed the decision in the office of the City Clerk on July 24, 1973; and

WHEREAS, the motion by the Planning Commission to approve said permit failed to receive four affirmative votes and was deemed denied; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 101.0454 of the San Diego Municipal Code, J. R. SHATTUCK appealed the decision of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, said appeal was set for public hearing on August 16, 1973, continued to August 21, 1973, and testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted and the City Council having fully considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; and

WHEREAS, the City Council in considering said appeal is empowered by the provisions of Municipal Code Section 101.0454 to affirm, reverse, or modify in whole or in part any determination of the Planning Commission, subject to the limitations as are

placed upon the Planning Commission by the Municipal Code; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

All of the following facts exist with respect to Land Conservation Permit No. 30:

- 1. The proposed development does not result in minimum disturbance of the natural terrain commensurate with the proposed use of the lot or premises.
- 2. Grading and excavation proposed in connection with the development will result in soil erosion, silting of lower slopes, and severe cutting or scarring.
- 3. The proposed development will not serve to preserve and enhance the natural environment and the aesthetic qualities of the site.

The above findings are further supported by the minutes, maps, tape of the proceedings and exhibits, all of which are herein incorporated by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that by a vote of 6-3, the appeal of J. R. SHATTUCK be, and it is hereby denied and Land Conservation Permit No. 30 is therefore denied.
