Conditional Use Permit No. 7297, Amendment No. 2

WHEREAS, SAN DIEGO CEMETERY ASSOCIATION, a California corporation, Owner, hereafter referred to as "Permittee," filed an application for an amendment to Conditional Use Permit No. 7297, to construct and operate a cemetery, located on the south side of Imperial Avenue, between 40th Street and Ada Street, more particularly described as portions of Lots E and F, Block 1, Central Homestead, Map No. 358, and all of Block 2, F. H. Zschockelts Subdivision, Map No. 397, on file in the office of the County Recorder, in the R-4 Zone; and

WHEREAS, on May 9, 1973, the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego made its findings of facts; granted said amendment to Permittee and filed the decision in the office of the City Clerk on May 31, 1973; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 101.0506 of the San Diego Municipal Code, SOUTHEAST SAN DIEGO DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE, by Brister Murdock, Chairman, appealed the decision of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, said appeal was set for public hearing on June 28, 1973, continued to August 30, 1973, testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted and the City Council having fully considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; and

WHEREAS, the City Council in considering said appeal is empowered by the provisions of Municipal Code Section 101.0506, paragraph "E.4.," to affirm, reverse, or modify in whole or in part any determination of the Planning Commission, subject to the limitations as are placed upon the Planning Commission by the Municipal Code; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

All of the following facts exist with respect to Conditional Use Permit No. 7297, Amendment No. 2:

- 1. The proposed use at the particular location is desirable to provide a service which will contribute to the general well-being of the community.
- 2. Such use will not, under the circumstances of the particular case, be detrimental to the health, safety or general welfare of persons residing or working in the vicinity.
- 3. The proposed use will comply with the regulations and conditions specified in the Code for such use.
- 4. The granting of this amendment will not adversely affect the Southeast San Diego Community Plan, the Master Plan of the City or the adopted plan of any governmental agency.

The above findings are further supported by the minutes, tape of the proceedings, maps and exhibits, all of which are herein incorporated by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that by a vote of 9 to 0, the appeal of Southeast San Diego Development Committee is hereby denied and this Council does hereby grant to San Diego Cemetery Association Conditional Use Permit No. 7297, Amendment No. 2, in the form and with the terms and conditions as set forth in the permit attached hereto and made a part hereof.

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CITY COUNCIL CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT NO. 7297, AMENDMENT NO. 2

This conditional use permit amendment is granted by the Council of The City of San Diego to SAN DIEGO CEMETERY ASSOCIATION, a California corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Permittee," for the purpose and under the terms and on the conditions as set out herein pursuant to the authority contained in Section 101.0507 of the San Diego Municipal Code.

- 1. Permission is hereby granted to Permittee to construct and operate a cemetery, located on the south side of Imperial Avenue, between 40th Street and Ada Street, more particularly described as portions of Lots E and F, Block 1, Central Homestead, Map No. 358, and all of Block 2, F. H. Zschockelts Subdivision, Map No. 397, on file in the office of the County Recorder, in the R-4 Zone.
- 2. The cemetery shall include, and the term "Project" as used in this conditional use permit amendment shall mean the total of the following facilities:
 - a. Existing mausoleum and columbarium facilities.
 - b. Mausoleum addition for 3200 crypts.
 - c. Existing mortuary and proposed crematory operations.
 - d. Existing chapel and related incidental facilities.
 - e. Off-street parking.
 - f. Incidental accessory uses as may be determined and approved by the Planning Director.

3. Not less than 70 off-street parking spaces shall be provided and maintained on the subject property in the approximate location shown on Exhibit A, dated May 9, 1973, on file in the office of the Planning Department. Each parking space shall be a minimum of 8-1/2' by 20' in size and shall not be converted for any other use. Areas and driveways shall be surfaced with not less than 2" A.C. or its equivalent and each parking space shall be marked. Parking spaces and aisles shall conform to Planning Department standards. No charge shall be made at any time for the use of these off-street parking spaces.

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- 4. The crematory operation will at all times be performed within the enclosed garage-crematory structure.
- 5. No. vehicular parking shall be permitted at any time on any of the private roadways within the development.
- 6. Permittee shall comply with the General Conditions for Conditional Use Permits attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Passed and adopted by the Council of The City of San Diego on August 30, 1973.

GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR CONDITIONAL USE PERMITS

- 1. Prior to the issuance of any building permits, complete building plans (including signs) shall be submitted to the Planning Director for approval. Plans shall be in substantial conformity with Exhibit A, dated May 9, 1973, on file in the office of the Planning Department. The property shall be developed in accordance with the approved building plans except where regulations of this or other governmental agencies require deviation therefrom. Prior to and subsequent to the completion of the project, no changes, modifications or alterations shall be made unless and until appropriate applications for amendment of this permit shall have been approved and granted.
- 2. Prior to the issuance of any building permits, a complete landscaping plan, including a permanent watering system, shall be submitted to the Planning Director for approval. Said plans shall be in substantial conformity with Exhibit A, dated

 On file in the office of the Planning

Department. Approved planting shall be installed prior to the issuance of an occupancy permit on any building. Such planting shall not be modified or altered unless and until this permit shall have been amended to permit such modification or alteration.

3. All outdoor lighting shall be so shaded and adjusted that the light therefrom is directed to fall only on the same premises where such light sources are located.

- 4. Substantial construction of the project shall have commenced and shall be proceeding within one year from the effective date of this conditional use permit or any extension of time as may be granted herein by The City of San Diego pursuant to the terms set forth in Section 101.0507 and Section 101.0508 of the San Diego Municipal Code.
- 5. Construction and operation of the approved use shall comply at all times with the regulations of this or other governmental agencies.
- 6. The effectiveness of this conditional use permit is expressly conditioned upon, and the same shall not become effective for any purpose unless and until the following events shall have occurred:
 - a. Permittee shall have agreed to each and every condition hereof by having this conditional use permit signed within 90 days of the Council's decision. In no event shall this condition be construed to extend the time limitation set forth in 4 above; i.e., the time commences to run on the date that the City Council granted this conditional use permit.
 - b. This conditional use permit executed as indicated shall have been recorded in the office of the County Recorder.
- 7. After the establishment of the project as provided herein, the subject property shall not be used for any other purposes unless specifically authorized by the Planning Commission, or

City Council, or both unless the proposed use meets every requirement of zone existing for the subject property at the time of conversion.

- 8. The property included within this conditional use permit shall be used only for the purposes and under the terms and conditions as set forth in this permit unless the permit shall have been revoked by The City of San Diego.
- 9. In addition to any other remedy provided by law, any breach in any of the terms or conditions of this permit or any default on the part of Permittee or its successors in interest, shall be deemed a material breach hereof and this conditional use permit may be cancelled or revoked. Cancellation or revocation of this conditional use permit may be instituted by City or Permittee. The Planning Director shall set this matter for public hearing before the Planning Commission giving the same notice as provided in Section 101.0506. An appeal from the decision of the Planning Commission may be taken to the City Council within ten days after the decision is filed with the City Clerk. The Clerk shall set the matter for public hearing before the City Council giving the same notice as provided in Section 101.0506.
- 10. This conditional use permit shall inure to the benefit of and shall constitute a covenant running with the lands, and the terms, conditions and provisions hereof shall be binding upon Permittee, and any successor or successors thereto, and the interests of any successor shall be subject to each and every condition herein set out.
