RESOLUTION NO. 208834

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, PROPOSING TO MAKE CHANGES INCREASING THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF THE ASSESSMENT AND THE AMOUNTS OF INDIVIDUAL ASSESSMENT; FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING PROTESTS AND OBJECTIONS TO SAID CHANGES AND GIVING NOTICE THEREOF.

(Mission Boulevard South Assessment District)

WHEREAS, in proceedings under the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913 (commencing with Section 10000, Streets and Highways Code) the Council adopted resolution of intention, Resolution No. 208252, ordering the City Engineer to prepare the Report required by said Act and pursuant thereto the City Engineer prepared said Report, consisting of plans and specifications describing the proposed improvements, an estimate of the costs and expenses thereof, a diagram showing the assessment district, and a proposed assessment of such costs and expenses, said Report being on file with the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Council by Resolution No. 208428 approved said Report, as filed, appointed a time and place of hearing thereon and said hearing was duly commenced and, by resolution of the Council, has been duly continued; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 208604, inviting bids for the construction of the portion of the

improvements designated "Contract No. 1," bids therefor were received and opened at the time and place fixed therefor and, based upon the lowest responsible bid received, it now appears that the total cost and incidental expenses of the improvements will exceed the estimate set forth in the original Report heretofore made and filed by the City Engineer; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has made and presented a Supplemental Report containing a revised estimate of the total costs and incidental expenses of the improvements; and

WHEREAS, if the improvements are ordered, as here-tofore proposed, it will be necessary to increase the total amount of the assessment and the amounts of individual assessments; NOW, THEREOFRE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. The Council hereby proposes and declares its intention to order the following changes to be made:

(a) After deducting the contribution proposed to be made by the city from the total costs and expenses of the improvements, the remainder of the costs and expenses

to be assessed upon assessable property within the assessment district shall be increased from \$1,016,000, as set forth in the original Report, to \$1,520,400.00, as set forth in the Supplemental Report;

(b) The amount of each individual assessment upon each assessable lot, piece, parcel, or condominium interest, as set forth in the proposed assessment contained in the original Report, shall be increased by approximately 50% of said amount. The amount of the revised assessment against the property of each owner shall show on the address insert enclosed with each mailed copy of this resolution.

Section 2. The amount of the estimated increase or decrease in the cost of the improvements is as follows:

The City Clerk is directed to publish this resolution in THE SAN DIEGO DAILY TRANSCRIPT, a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in said city, and to mail copies thereof to all persons owning real property within the assessment district whose assessments are proposed to be increased.

Section 5. The revised proposed amount of each individual assessment upon each lot, piece, parcel or condominium interest shall be shown on the address insert accompanying the copy of this resolution mailed to the owner thereof.
