

RESOLUTION NO. 208849 SEP 18 1973

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AND DENOMINATED AS IMPERIAL AVENUE, 28TH STREET TO 32ND STREET, UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 208588, a public hearing was called for on SEP 18 1973 at the hour of 9:30 a.m. in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, 202 C Street, San Diego, California, to determine whether the public health, safety or general welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within that certain area of the City of San Diego more particularly described as follows:

Lots 39 and 40, Block 2, and Lot 2 and the easterly 8 feet of Lot 3, Block 3, Reed's Central Addition, Map No. 981; Lots 4 and 5, Block 77, Seaman and Choate Addition, Map No. 300; Lots 7 through 11, 14 and 15, 19 through 24 and the easterly 12.5 feet of Lot 18, Block 104, and Lots 1 through 4, 6 through 13, 18 through 22, and the westerly 15 feet of Lot 14, Block 107, Central Park, Map No. 107;

said district shall include the following described public right of way:

IMPERIAL AVENUE, between a line parallel to and 75 feet easterly of the easterly line of 28th Street and a line parallel to and 50 feet easterly of the easterly line of 32nd Street; 29TH STREET, between lines parallel to and 100 feet southerly and northerly of the southerly and northerly lines of

Imperial Avenue, respectively; 31ST STREET, between lines parallel to and 50 feet southerly and 25 feet northerly of the southerly and northerly lines of Imperial Avenue, respectively;

and all as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 15792-D, entitled IMPERIAL AVENUE, 28TH STREET TO 32ND STREET, UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT, copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 744529 and attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing has been given by the City Clerk to all affected property owners as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and the utilities concerned in the manner and for the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held and all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The City Council does hereby find and determine that the public health, safety and general welfare require the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within the area set forth above and that pursuant to Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the

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San Diego Municipal Code, the above-described area is hereby declared to be an underground utility district in the City of San Diego, and the maps and document referred to above are hereby incorporated as a part of this resolution.

2. Pursuant to Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code the following exceptions shall be allowed in said underground utility district:

Temporary traffic signals and street lights located at the intersection of Imperial Avenue and 32nd Street. These facilities are to be replaced in 1975 by CIP Project No. 52-022.6.

3. The City Council shall by subsequent resolution fix the date upon which the property in the district must be ready to receive underground service, and shall by subsequent resolution order the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service.

4. The City Clerk be and he is hereby instructed to notify all affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and all affected utility companies of the adoption of this resolution within fifteen (15) days after the date of such adoption. The City Clerk shall further notify said affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal

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
Code of the necessity that if they desire to continue to receive electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service, they shall provide at their own expense all necessary facility changes on their premises so as to receive underground service from the lines relocated underground of the supplying utility company subject to applicable rules, regulations and tariffs of the respective utility company on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California (as of the date of adoption of this resolution) and subject to all other applicable requirements of State law and City ordinances. The Clerk's notification shall be made in the manner provided in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code.

5. The City Council hereby finds that the underground utility district created herein is required by the public health, safety and general welfare for the following reason:

This street is extensively used by the general public and carries a heavy volume of pedestrian and vehicular traffic.

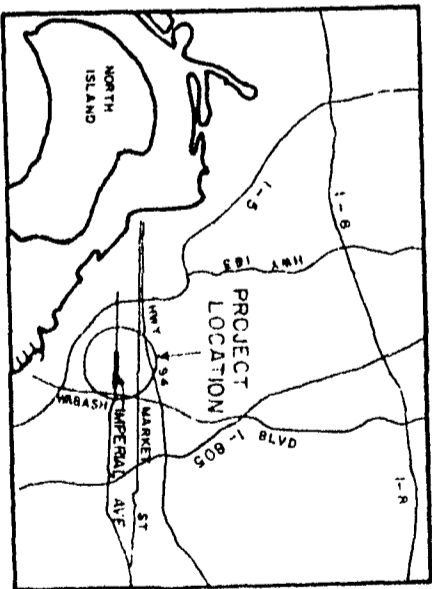
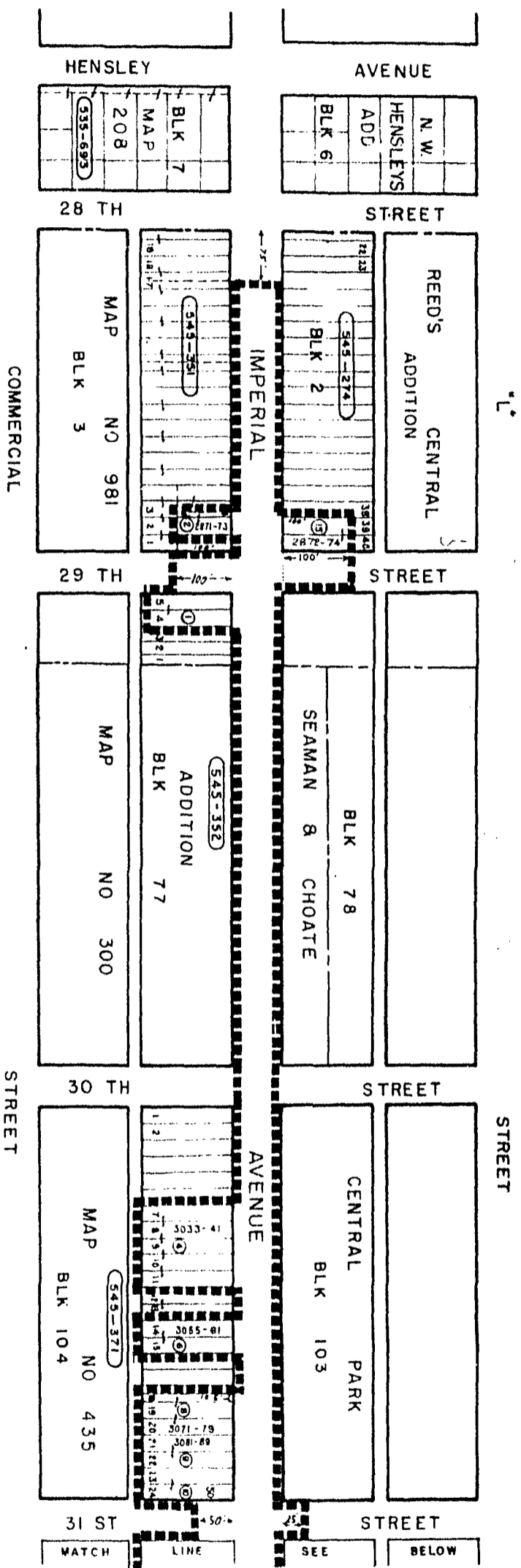
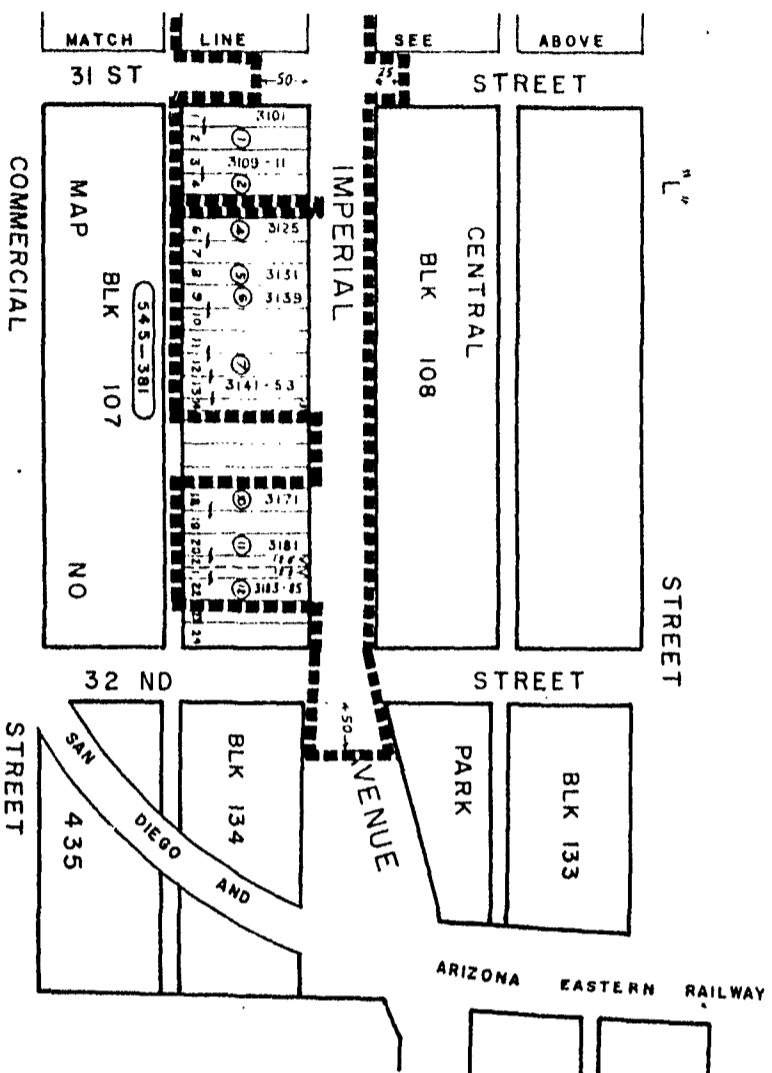

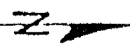
