WHEREAS, the population of the San Diego region now exceeds one and one-half million people in thirteen different cities as well as the unincorporated area of the County; and

WHEREAS, these thirteen cities and the County share a common air basin, water table and transportation network; and

WHEREAS, the need for an integrated comprehensive approach to the resolution of problems of mutual concern has never been greater; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego County legislative delegation has encouraged local government to investigate restructuring as a means of more effectively dealing with these common problems; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That The City of San Diego supports in concept the idea of a reorganization of local governments in order to more effectively deal with the problems of the San Diego region and particularly of the urban area.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego supports in given order of priority the following sources of funding to carry out such a study:

- a. 701 planning grant from the Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development; or
 - b. An allocation of funds from AB 835; or

c. A one-year, one-cent increase in the County property tax.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all local governmental entities within the County of San Diego are urged to join forces and cooperate in this endeavor so that problems of mutual concern to all within the San Diego region may be more effectively resolved through united effort.
