That those portions of Lot 3, Mission Valley Shopping Center, shown as "Reserved for Future Street" according to Map thereof No. 4244, filed in the San Diego County Recorder's Office, June 30, 1959, as more particularly described in the legal description attached hereto as Exhibit A, be and the same are hereby dedicated as and for a public street and the same are hereby named CAMINO DE LA REINA.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

CAMINO DE LA REINA

Parcel 1

All that portion of Lot 3, Mission Valley Shopping Center, shown as "Reserved for Future Street" according to Map thereof No. 4244, filed in the San Diego County Recorder's Office, June 30, 1959, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of said Lot 3; thence along the Northerly line of said Lot 3 South $72^{\circ}08'36''$ West, 53.07 feet to a point in a line lying 53.00 feet Westerly measured at right angles to and parallel with the Easterly line of said Lot, said Easterly line bears North $14^{\circ}43'55''$ West, said point being the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence along said parallel line South $14^{\circ}43'55''$ East, 64.23 feet to a point of cusp with a 20.00 foot radius curve, concave Southwesterly; thence leaving said parallel line Northwesterly along the arc of said curve through a central angle of $83^{\circ}57'55''$, a distance of 29.31 feet to a point of reverse curvature with a 523.70 foot radius curve, concave Northeasterly to which a radial line bears South $08^{\circ}41'50''$ East; thence Northwesterly along the arc of said curve through a central angle of $16^{\circ}04'29''$, a distance of 146.93 feet to a point in said Northerly line of Lot 3 to which a radial line bears South $07^{\circ}22'39''$ West; thence leaving said curve along said Northerly line North $72^{\circ}08'36''$ East, 160.19 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

Parcel 2

All that portion of Lot 3, Mission Valley Shopping Center, shown as "Reserved for Future Street" according to Map thereof No. 4244, filed in the San Diego County Recorder's Office, June 30, 1959, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of said Lot 3; thence along the Northerly line of said Lot 3 North $72^{\circ}08'36''$ East, 670.50 feet to a point in the arc of a non-tangent 522.24 foot radius curve, concave Northwesterly to which a radial line bears South $43^{\circ}08'05''$ East; thence Southwesterly along the arc of said curve through a central angle of $25^{\circ}16'41''$, a distance of 230.40 feet; thence tangent to said curve along a line lying 50.00 feet Southerly measured at right angles to and parallel with said Northerly line South $72^{\circ}08'36''$ West, 422.51 feet to the beginning of a tangent 25.00 foot radius curve, concave Southeasterly; thence leaving said parallel line Southwesterly and Southerly along the arc of said curve through a central angle of $90^{\circ}00'28''$, a distance of 39.27 feet to a point of cusp with the Westerly line of said Lot 3 to which a radial line bears South $72^{\circ}08'08''$ West; thence leaving said curve along said Westerly line North $17^{\circ}51'52''$ West, 49.99 feet; thence North $17^{\circ}49'39''$ West, 25.01 feet to the Point of Beginning.
