

Adopted on OCT 11 1973

That that portion of Lot 5, Mission Valley Shopping Center, shown as "Reserved for Future Street," according to Map thereof No. 4244, filed in the San Diego County Recorder's Office, June 30, 1959, as more particularly described in the legal description attached hereto as Exhibit A, be, and the same is hereby dedicated as and for a public street and the same is hereby named CAMINO DE LA REINA.

That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this resolution for record in the office of the Recorder of San Diego County.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Camino de la Reina

All that portion of Lot 5, Mission Valley Shopping Center, shown as "Reserved for Future Street", according to Map thereof No. 4244, filed in the San Diego County Recorder's Office, June 30, 1959, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Lot 5; thence South $17^{\circ}49'39''$ East along the Easterly line of said Lot 5, a distance of 24.99 feet; thence South $17^{\circ}51'52''$ East, a distance of 50.01 feet to a point of cusp with a tangent 25.00 foot radius curve, concave Southerly; thence leaving said Easterly line Northerly and Westerly along the arc of said 25.00 foot radius curve through a central angle of $89^{\circ}59'32''$, a distance of 39.27 feet; thence tangent to said curve South $72^{\circ}08'36''$ West, 594.56 feet; thence North $17^{\circ}51'24''$ West, 50.00 feet to an intersection with said Northerly line of Lot 5; thence North $72^{\circ}08'36''$ East (Record North $71^{\circ}36'42''$ East), 619.56 feet along said Northerly line to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.
