BE IT RESOLVED, that the Golden Hall, Plaza Hall and Civic
Theatre, formerly known as the "Community Concourse," shall
hereafter be known as the "CONVENTION AND PERFORMING ARTS CENTER."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the entire complex, consisting of the City Administration Building, Convention and Performing Arts Center, Municipal Parking Garage and City Operations Building, shall hereafter be known as "THE CHARLES C. DAIL CONCOURSE."
