A RESOLUTION ELECTING TO PROCEED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE STREET VACATION ACT OF 1941, DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO VACATE LAUREL STREET BETWEEN ELKHART AND 51ST STREETS; 51ST STREET BETWEEN LAUREL AND ELKHART STREETS; AN UNNAMED STREET (EXTENSION OF LAUREL STREET) BETWEEN 51ST AND 52ND STREETS; AND A PORTION OF ELKHART STREET BETWEEN LAUREL AND 51ST STREETS AND FIXING A TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING THEREOF.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the public interest and convenience of said City require the vacation of the streets hereinafter mentioned; and in connection therewith require the reservation of a certain easement for drainage purposes within the area covered by such streets.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the intention of said

Council to order the vacation of LAUREL STREET between Elkhart and

5lst Streets; 5lST STREET between Laurel and Elkhart Streets; an

UNNAMED STREET (extension of Laurel Street) between 5lst and

52nd Streets; and a portion of ELKHART STREET between Laurel and

5lst Streets, as more particularly shown on Map No. 15931-D, on

file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 745378 .

The Council hereby elects to proceed, in making said vacation, under the provisions of the "Street Vacation Act of 1941."

The Council hereby fixes 9:30 A.M., NOV 2 7 1973, in the Council Chamber on the twelfth floor of the City Administration Building, Community Concourse, 202 C Street, in said City of San Diego, as the time and place for hearing all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation.

That The Daily Transcript, a daily newspaper published and circulated, and of general circulation, in the said City of San Diego, be, and it is hereby designated as the newspaper in which the Street Superintendent of said City shall cause to be published, in the manner and form required by law, notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention, and the said Street Superintendent is hereby directed to cause notices of the passage of this resolution to be posted in the manner and form required by law and to cause a notice similar in substance to be published in said newspaper in the manner required by law.
