RESOLUTION NO. 209215

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, PROPOSING TO MAKE CHANGES INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF AN INDIVIDUAL ASSESSMENT; FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING PROTESTS AND OBJECTIONS TO SAID CHANGES AND GIVING NOTICE THEREOF.

(Mission Boulevard South Assessment District)

WHEREAS, in proceedings under the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913 (commencing with Section 10000, Streets and Highways Code) the Council adopted resolution of intention, Resolution No. 208252, ordering the City Engineer to prepare the Report required by said Act and pursuant thereto the City Engineer prepared said Report, consisting of plans and specifications describing the proposed improvements, an estimate of the costs and expenses thereof, a diagram showing the assessment district, and a proposed assessment of such costs and expenses, said Report being on file with the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Council by Resolution No. 208428

approved said Report, as filed, appointed a time and place of hearing thereon and said hearing was duly commenced and, by resolution of the Council, has been duly continued; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended to the City
Council that the amount proposed to be assessed upon Assessment
Parcel No. 1 be increased; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. The Council hereby proposes and declares its intention to order that the assessable area of Assessment Parcel No. 1 be increased from 1.1 acres, as presently proposed, to the entire surface area of said parcel and that said increased assessable area be assessed at the same rate and on the same basis as all other assessable area within the proposed assessment district.

Section 2. The changes herein proposed will not result in any estimated increase or decrease in the cost of the improvements.

Section 3. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that November 20, 1973 at the hour of 11:00 A.M. in the Council Chamber at the City Administration Building, 202 "C" Street, San Diego, California, are the day, hour and place when and where all interested persons having any objection to the changes proposed herein may appear before the Council and show cause why said changes should not be ordered. Written objections to the proposed changes may be filed with the City Clerk by any interested person at any time not later than the time set for hearing.
