Mary B. Jarrell	POLICE DEPARTMENT	\$35	Intermediate Typist Mary Jarrell is engaged in filing Impound-Recovery-Release reports in the Records Division. The filing policy required several steps. Ms. Jarrell reviewed the uses of the file and proposed a system that saves time both in filing and in using the files, without any loss of effectiveness.
Karen T. Hurley	POLICE DEPARTMENT	\$30	Ms. Hurley is an Intermediate Typist in the Traffic Division. She reviewed the processing, routing and filing of the Accident Reports and Traffic Accident Route Slips, two forms used for traffic accidents. She proposed that these two forms be combined. This has been done for a saving in clerical time and in form costs. Errors have also been reduced.
Bert L. Holmes	PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT Sanitation Division	\$25	Mr. Holmes suggested that the County take over the picking up and disposition of animal heads examined at the County Public Health Laboratory. This has been done for a saving of \$250 per year that this cost the City.
Dale Farlow	PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT Equipment Division	\$15	About a year ago, Mr Farlow received a \$30 award for suggesting wear-reducing bars for hopper edges on packer trucks. It has since been found that the savings are \$150 higher than estimated. This is an additional award of \$15.
Lawrence E. Murphy	WATER UTILITIES DEPARTMENT	\$10	Mr. Murphy is Plant Operator II at the Alvarado Filtration Plant. He felt that there should be better illumination outside at the west end of the plant. This has been done so that a gauge can be read on the reservoir more readily and intruders can be seen in the area.
