WHEREAS, The City of San Diego through its Police Department desires to undertake a research project to develop procedures for handling extremely hazardous situations such as armed and barricaded suspects, kidnap-hostage situations, sniper-ambush incidents, VIP security, etc.; and

WHEREAS, such project will include the preparation of a detailed manual covering procedures encompassing such situations and the purchase of necessary equipment; and

WHEREAS, the California Council on Criminal Justice, herein called "CCCJ," has indicated that funds are available through the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, Public Law 90-355, as amended by Public Law 91-644, herein called "Safe Streets Act," administered by CCCJ; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager be and he is hereby fully authorized and empowered to submit, for and on behalf of said City, a grant application to the CCCJ in the amount of \$139,365 for the purposes of researching and improving the handling of "hazardous situations," pursuant to the terms and agreement of the form of grant application on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 745794

- 2. That the City Manager be and he is hereby further fully authorized and empowered to execute said grant contract with CCCJ when awarded.
- 3. That the City Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized to transfer the sum of \$5,226 from the Unallocated Reserve (53.30) to the Allocated Reserve (53.20) to be used solely and exclusively for the purpose of meeting the City's cash-match requirement as set forth in said grant application.
