

ORDINANCE NO. 11290 APR 8 1974  
(New Series)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 7 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY REPEALING SECTION 67.57, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 67.55, 67.56, 67.58, 67.59 AND 67.62, AND BY ADDING SECTION 67.63 ALL RELATING TO THE WATER SYSTEM.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VI, Article 7, of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and the same is hereby amended by repealing Section 67.57.

Section 2. That Chapter VI, Article 7, of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and the same is hereby amended by amending Sections 67.55, 67.56, 67.58, 67.59 and 67.62 to read as follows:

SEC. 67.55 WATER RATES - GENERAL WATER SERVICE  
WITHIN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO

The rates to be charged and collected for water supplied in any one month for Domestic, Commercial and Industrial use within the City, and for all purposes for which no other rate for water supplied for use within the City is provided in this Article shall be as follows:

a. Customer Charge, per meter:

b. In addition to the Customer Charge, above, there shall be a Commodity Charge of \$0.292 for each unit of 100 cubic feet.

**SEC. 67.56 WATER RATES - GENERAL WATER SERVICE  
OUTSIDE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO**

The rates to be charged and collected for water supplied in any one month for Domestic, Commercial and Industrial use outside the City, and for all purposes for which no other rate for water supplied for use outside the City is provided in this Article, shall be as follows: the amount computed at the rates set forth under Section 67.55 above, multiplied by 2.00.

Nothing contained in this section shall be construed to change or modify any existing legal contracts or obligations between The City of San Diego and any person, firm or corporation as to the rate or rates for water or the obligations in connection therewith.

**SEC. 67.58 WATER RATES - FIRE HYDRANT SERVICE  
WITHIN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO**

The rate to be charged and collected for Fire Hydrant service within the City (which shall include maintenance of the hydrant in accordance with

Section 55.1 of the Municipal Code, and water used for fire extinguishing purposes) shall be as follows:

Rate Schedule:

Flat rate.

For each such fire hydrant located on City property \$ 6.00 per annum

When the private property owner contracts with City for fire hydrant maintenance, for each such fire hydrant located on such private property 42.00 per annum

SEC. 67.59 WATER RATES - FIRE SERVICE AND AUTOMATIC FIRE SPRINKLER SERVICE WITHIN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO

The rates to be charged and collected for any one month for Fire Service and Automatic Fire Sprinkler service WITHIN the City of San Diego shall be as follows:

1 1/2 inch	\$ 5.25
2 inch	7.00
3 inch	10.50
4 inch	14.00
6 inch	21.00
8 inch	28.00
10 inch	35.00
12 inch	42.00
16 inch	56.00
20 inch	70.00

No water shall be used otherwise than for fire extinguishing purposes from Fire Services or Automatic Fire Sprinkler Services. Upon evidence of violation

of this provision, the Water Utilities Department shall install a meter of appropriate size and design at the Consumer's expense, if service is not already metered, and all water so used shall be charged and collected for at twice the rate for General Water Service WITHIN the City specified in this Article.

SEC. 67.62 WATER RATES - SERVICE TO THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT

The rates to be charged and collected for water and water service supplied to the United States Government or any of its Departments or Agencies WITHIN the City of San Diego, shall be the same as those rates in effect for all Consumers WITHIN the City, as specified in this Article.

Section 3. That Chapter VI, Article 7, of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and the same is hereby amended by adding Section 67.63 to read as follows:

SEC. 67.63 WATER RATE - SERVICE TO THE UNITED STATES NAVY--CORONADO

Due to extensive services which the Navy provides at the below specified facilities thus relieving the City from providing such services, the rate to be charged and collected for water and water service supplied to the United States Navy at North Island Naval Air Station and/or the Navy Amphibious Base in Coronado shall be \$0.292 for each unit of 100 cubic feet.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 7 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY REPEALING SECTION 67.57, AMENDING SECTIONS 67.55, 67.56, 67.58, 67.59 AND 67.62, AND ADDING SECTION 67.63 ALL RELATING TO THE WATER SYSTEM, AS IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VI, Article 7, of the San Diego Municipal Code, and the same is hereby amended by repealing Section 67.57.

Section 2. That Chapter VI, Article 7, of the San Diego Municipal Code, and the same is hereby amended by amending Sections 67.55, 67.56, 67.58, 67.59 and 67.62 to read as follows:

**SEC. 67.55 WATER RATES — GENERAL WATER SERVICE WITHIN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO**

The rates to be charged and collected for water supplied in any one month for Domestic, Commercial and Industrial use within the City, and for all purposes for which no other rate for water supplied for use within the City is provided in this Article shall be as follows:

a. Customer Charge, per meter:	Amount

6 inch	225.00
8 inch	300.00

b. In addition to the Customer Charge, above, there shall be a Commodity Charge of \$0.292 for each unit of 100 cubic feet.

**SEC. 67.56 WATER RATES — GENERAL WATER SERVICE OUTSIDE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO**

The rates to be charged and collected for water supplied in any one month for Domestic, Commercial and Industrial use outside the City, and for all purposes for which no other rate for water supplied for use outside the City is provided in this Article, shall be as follows: the amount computed at the rates set forth under Section 67.55 above, multiplied by 2.00.

Nothing contained in this section shall be construed to change or modify any existing legal contracts or obligations between The City of San Diego and any person, firm or corporation as to the rate or rates for water or the obligations in connection therewith.

**SEC. 67.58 WATER RATES — FIRE HYDRANT SERVICE WITHIN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO**

The rate to be charged and collected for Fire Hydrant service within the City (which shall include maintenance of the hydrant in accordance with Section 55.1 of the Municipal Code, and water used for fire extinguishing purposes) shall be as follows:

For each such fire hydrant located on City property	\$ 6.00 per annum
When the private property owner contracts with City for fire hydrant maintenance, for each such fire hydrant located on such private property	42.00 per annum

**SEC. 67.59 WATER RATES — FIRE SERVICE AND AUTOMATIC FIRE SPRINKLER SERVICE WITHIN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO**

The rates to be charged and collected for any one month for Fire Service and Automatic Fire Sprinkler service WITHIN the City of San Diego shall be as follows:

1 1/2 inch	\$ 5.25
2 inch	7.00
3 inch	10.50
4 inch	14.00
6 inch	21.00
8 inch	28.00
10 inch	35.00
12 inch	42.00
16 inch	56.00
20 inch	70.00

No water shall be used otherwise than for fire extinguishing purposes from Fire Service or Automatic Fire Sprinkler Services. Upon evidence of violation of this provision, the Water Utilities Department shall install a meter of appropriate size and design at the Consumer's expense. If service is not already metered and all water so used shall be charged and collected for at twice the rate for General Water Service WITHIN the City specified in this Article.

**SEC. 67.62 WATER RATES — SERVICE TO THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT**

The rates to be charged and collected for water and water service supplied to the United States Government or any of its Departments or Agencies WITHIN the City of San Diego, shall be the same as those rates in effect for all Consumers WITHIN the City, as specified in this Article.

Section 3. That Chapter VI, Article 7, of the San Diego Municipal Code, and the same is hereby amended by adding Section 67.63 to read as follows:

**SEC. 67.63 WATER RATE — SERVICE TO THE UNITED STATES NAVY — CORONADO**

Due to existing services which the Navy provides at the below specified facilities, thus relieving the City from providing such services, the rate to be charged and collected for water and water service supplied to the United States Navy at North Island Naval Air Station and/or the Navy Amphibious Base in Coronado shall be \$0.292 for each unit of 100 cubic feet.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the date it becomes law, and after its passage.
