

ORDINANCE NO. 11304 **APR 18 1974**  
(New Series)

AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING THAT PROPERTY IN THE KEARNY VISTA COMMUNITY BEGINNING IN THE NORTH WITH THE HOUSING SURROUNDING THE LINDA VISTA BOYS' CLUB, AND GENERALLY SOUTH AND WEST OF COMSTOCK STREET, AND SOUTH OF BURTON AND COOLIDGE STREETS, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, INTO R-2A ZONE, AS DEFINED BY SECTION 101.0410 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 13457, APPROVED FEBRUARY 15, 1932, AND ORDINANCE NO. 3729 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED MAY 4, 1948, OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO INSOFAR AS THE SAME CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That property in the Kearny Vista Community beginning in the north with the housing surrounding the Linda Vista Boys' Club, and generally south and west of Comstock Street, and south of Burton and Coolidge Streets, in the City of San Diego, California, within the boundary of the district designated "R-2A" on Zone Map Drawing No. C-400.2, filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 747139, be, and it is hereby incorporated into R-2A Zone as such zone is described and defined by Section 101.0410 of the San Diego Municipal Code.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 13457, approved February 15, 1932, and Ordinance No. 3729 (New Series), adopted May 4, 1948, of the Ordinances of The City of San Diego be, and the same are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
