

ORDINANCE NO. 11314  
(New Series)

MAY 2 1974

AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING THAT PROPERTY IN THE KEARNY VISTA COMMUNITY GENERALLY BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY LINDA VISTA ROAD, ON THE EAST BY GOSHEN AND HUENEME STREETS, ON THE SOUTH BY FRIARS ROAD AND ON THE WEST BY MOLLIE STREET, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, INTO R-3 ZONE, AS DEFINED BY SECTION 101.0411 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 85 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED NOVEMBER 21, 1932, OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO INsofar AS IT CONFLICTS HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That property in the Kearny Vista Community generally bounded on the north by Linda Vista Road, on the east by Goshen and Hueneme Streets, on the south by Friars Road and on the west by Mollie Street, in the City of San Diego, California, within the boundary of the district designated "R-3" on Zone Map Drawing No. C-402.2, filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 747069, be, and it is hereby incorporated into R-3 Zone as such zone is described and defined by Section 101.0411 of the San Diego Municipal Code.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 85 (New Series), adopted November 21, 1932, of the Ordinances of The City of San Diego, be, and the same is hereby repealed insofar as it conflicts herewith.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage, and no building
