AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 10870 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED JULY 13, 1972, INCORPORATING A PORTION OF RANCHO SAN BERNARDO IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, INTO M-IP ZONE, AS DEFINED BY SECTION 101.0435.1 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, a request has been received to extend the time on Ordinance No. 10870 (New Series), adopted July 13, 1972; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance No. 10870 provided that the M-IP Zone would attach if a final subdivision map or maps were recorded on or before August 12, 1974; and

WHEREAS, the requested extension of time will permit the successful conclusion and implementation of the zoning pattern heretofore approved by the Planning Commission; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 10870 (New Series), adopted July 13, 1972, be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That in the event that a portion of Rancho San Bernardo, in the City of San Diego, California, within the boundary of the district designated "M-IP" on that certain Zone Map Drawing No. B-2606.1, is subdivided and a final subdivision map or maps thereof duly recorded

on or before August 12, 1975, and within such subdivision or subdivisions, provision is made for the installation of public utility services and the dedication of streets, alleys and easements for public use, the provisions of Section 101.0435.1 of the San Diego Municipal Code shall attach and become applicable to the said subdivided land and the said subdivided land shall be incorporated into M-IP Zone, as described by Section 101.0435.1 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the boundary of such zone to be as indicated on Zone Map Drawing No. B-2606.1, filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 740124. Said zoning shall attach only to those areas included in the subdivision map or maps recorded as provided in this section.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
