AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2,
OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING
DIVISION 23, SECTIONS 22.2301 AND 22.2302
RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE
ANALYST.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 2, of the San Diego
Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by adding
Division 23, Sections 22.2301 and 22.2302 to read as follows:

Division 23

Department of Legislative Analyst

SEC. 22.2301 DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE ANALYST

The Department of Legislative Analyst is a City
Department. The Director of the department is the
Legislative Analyst who is the administrative head of
the department. He shall be appointed by and removed
by a majority of the Council.

SEC. 22.2302 POWERS AND DUTIES OF LEGISLATIVE ANALYST

The Legislative Analyst shall assist the Council in
the conduct of legislative inquiries and in the making of
legislative decisions. The scope of the department's
activities shall be defined by the Council at periodic
meetings acting as the Committee of the Whole or by such
procedures as the Council acting as the Committee of the
Whole shall hereafter adopt.



Division 23
