AN ORDINANCE SETTING ASIDE AND DEDICATING A CERTAIN PORTION OF EX-MISSION LANDS OF SAN DIEGO, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, FOR A PUBLIC PARK AND NAMING SAID PARK "GOMPER'S PARK."

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego is the owner of certain Ex-Mission Lands of San Diego, in the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the people of the City of San Diego to set aside and dedicate forever portions of said Ex-Mission Lands of San Diego, hereinafter described, for public use and enjoyment as and for a public park to be used by all the public for park and recreational purposes; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described real property be and the same is hereby set aside and dedicated in perpetuity as a public park to be used by all the public for park and recreational purposes.

Section 2. That the hereinafter described real property be and the same is hereby named "Gomper's Park."

Section 3. That the real property so dedicated and named is described as follows:





Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
