AN ORDINANCE SETTING ASIDE AND DEDICATING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF PUEBLO LANDS IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, FOR A PUBLIC PARK AND NAMING SAID PARK "MOUNT ACADIA PARK."

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego is the owner of certain Pueblo Lands in The City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the people of The City of San Diego to set aside and dedicate forever portions of said Pueblo Lands, hereinafter described, for public use and enjoyment as and for a public park to be used by all the public for park and recreational purposes; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described real property be and the same is hereby set aside and dedicated in perpetuity as a public park to be used by all the public for park and recreational purposes.

Section 2. That the hereinafter described real property be and the same is hereby named "Mount Acadia Park."

Section 3. That the real property so dedicated and named is described in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein.

Section 4. That the City Clerk of said City be and he is hereby authorized and directed to file for record in the office of the Recorder of San Diego County a certified copy of this ordinance.



PARCEL NO. 1 (Mount Acadia Park)

That portion of Pueblo Lots 1212 and 1221 of the Pueblo Lands of San Diego, in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, according to Map thereof by James Pascoe, a copy of which was filed in the County Recorder's Office and is known as Miscellaneous Map No. 36, described as follows:

Beginning at the point on the North line of Lots 448 and 449 of Clairemont Park Unit No. 2, according to Map thereof No. 3698 filed in the County Recorder's Office, in said County, which is distant thereon North $77^{\circ}48'25''$ East 720.00 feet from the Northwest corner of said Lot 449 of Clairemont Park Unit No. 2; thence along the Northerly line of said Lots 448 and 449 South $77^{\circ}59'13''$ West 720.00 feet to said Northwest corner of Lot 449; thence along the boundary of said Clairemont Park Unit No. 2, North $12^{\circ}13'04''$ West 487.68 feet to the Southerly line of that parcel of land described in deed to San Diego Unified School District of San Diego County, recorded July 11, 1958 as Document No. 111483 in Book 7162, page 342 of Official Records; thence along said Southerly line North $77^{\circ}48'25''$ East 615.71 feet to an angle point therein; thence Southerly in a straight line to the point of beginning.



AN ORDINANCE SETTING ASIDE AND DEDICATING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF PUEBLO LANDS BY THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, FOR A PUBLIC PARK AND NAMING SAID PARK "MOUNT ACADIA PARK."

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego is the owner of certain Pueblo Lands in The City of San Diego;

and WHEREAS, it is the desire of the people of The City of San Diego to set aside and dedicate forever portions of said Pueblo Lands, hereinafter described, for public use and enjoyment as and for a public park to be used by all the public for park and recreational purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described real property be and the same is hereby set aside and dedicated in perpetuity as a public park to be used by all the public for park and recreational purposes.

Section 2. That the hereinafter described real property be and the same is hereby named "Mount Acadia Park."

Section 3. That the real property so dedicated and named is described in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein.

Section 4. That the City Clerk of said City be and he is hereby authorized and directed to file for record in the office of the Recorder of San Diego County a certified copy of this ordinance.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the seventh day from and after its passage.

PARCEL NO. 1 (Mount Acadia Park)

That portion of Pueblo Lots 1212 and 1221 of the Pueblo Lands of San Diego, in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, according to Map thereof by James Pascoe, a copy of which was filed in the County Recorder's Office and is known as Miscellaneous Map No. 36, described as follows:

Beginning at the point on the North line of Lots 448 and 449 of Clairemont Park Unit No. 2 according to Map thereof No. 2898 filed in the County Recorder's Office, in said County, which is distant thereon North 77° 45' 25" East 720.00 feet from the Northwest corner of said Lot 448 of Clairemont Park No. 2; thence along the Northern line of said Lots 448 and 449 South 77° 29' 12" West 720.00 feet to said Northwest corner of Lot 448; thence along the boundary of said Clairemont Park Unit No. 2 North 12° 15' 04" West 467.00 feet to the Southern line of that parcel of land described in deed in San Diego Unified School District of San Diego County, recorded July 11, 1968 as Document No. 111483 in Book 7162, page 202 of Official Records; thence along said Southern line North 77° 45' 25" East 612.71 feet to the single corner point of said parcel of land; thence
