AN ORDINANCE SETTING ASIDE AND DEDICATING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF THE EAST SAN DIEGO AREA, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, FOR A PUBLIC PARK AND NAMING SAID PARK "OAK PARK."

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego is the owner of certain lands in the East San Diego area in the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the people of The City of San Diego to set aside and dedicate forever portions of said land in the East San Diego area, hereinafter described, for public use and enjoyment as and for a public park to be used by all the public for park and recreational purposes; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described real property be and the same is hereby set aside and dedicated in perpetuity as a public park to be used by all the public for park and recreational purposes.

Section 2. That the hereinafter described real property be and the same is hereby named "Oak Park."

Section 3. That the real property so dedicated and named is described in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein.

PARCEL NO. 3 (Oak Park)

All that portion of the West 396.00 feet of the North one-third of the South half of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 34, Township 16 South, Range 2 West, S.B.B.M., in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, being a portion of Rancho Mission of San Diego, as surveyed by M. O. Wheeler, County Surveyor in May 1871, being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Lot 4, Wadsworth Olive Grove according to Map thereof No. 482, filed in the Office of the Recorder of said San Diego County, said point of commencement being also the Northwest corner of the South one-half of the Southwest quarter of said Section 34; thence South $89^{\circ}52'45''$ East 396.00 feet; thence South $00^{\circ}07'15''$ West 5.00 feet along the Easterly boundary of said Westerly 396.00 feet of said Section 34, to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence continuing Southerly along said Easterly boundary to a point of intersection with the Northerly boundary of Clearview Manor, Map No. 2876, filed with said San Diego County Recorder; thence Westerly along said Northerly boundary 366.00 feet; thence North $00^{\circ}13'48''$ West 407.48 feet to the beginning of a 10.00 foot radius curve, concave Southeasterly; thence Northerly, Northeasterly and Easterly along the arc of said curve, through a central angle of $91^{\circ}21'03''$, an arc length of 15.94 feet; thence South $89^{\circ}52'45''$ East 142.11 feet, more or less, to a point which bears South $84^{\circ}45'28''$ West 213.98 feet from the True Point of Beginning; thence North $84^{\circ}45'28''$ East 213.98 feet returning to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

AN ORDINANCE SETTING ASIDE AND DEDICATING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF THE EAST SAN DIEGO AREA, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, FOR A PUBLIC PARK AND NAMING SAID PARK "OAK PARK."

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego is the owner of certain lands in the East San Diego area in the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, It is the desire of the people of The City of San Diego to set aside and dedicate forever portions of said land in the East San Diego area, hereinafter described, for public use and enjoyment as and for a public park to be used by all the public for park and recreational purposes: NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described real property be and the same is hereby set aside and dedicated in perpetuity as a public park to be used by all the public for park and recreational purposes.

All that portion of the West 226.00 feet of the North one-third of the South half of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 34, Township 16 South, Range 2 West, S.B.M., in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, being a portion of Rancho Mission of San Diego, as surveyed by M. O. Wheeler, County Surveyor in May 1871, being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Lot 4, Wadsworth Olive Grove according to Map thereof No. 482, filed in the Office of the Recorder of said San Diego County, said point of commencement being also the Northwest corner of the South one-half of the Southwest quarter of said Section 34; thence South 89° 52' 45" East 226.00 feet; thence South 00° 07' 15" West 5.00 feet along the Easterly boundary of said Westerly 226.00 feet of said Section 34, to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence continuing Southerly along said Easterly boundary to a point of intersection with the Northerly boundary of Clearview Manor, Map No. 2876, filed with said San Diego County Recorder; thence Westerly along said Northerly boundary 266.00 feet; thence North 00° 13' 48" West 497.48 feet in the beginning of a 10.00 foot radius curve, concave Southeastery; thence Northerly, Southeastery and Easterly along the arc of said curve, through a central angle of 81° 21' 08" an arc length of 15.94 feet; thence South 89° 52' 45" East 122.11 feet, more or less, to a point which bears South 84° 02' 30" West 212.00 feet from the True Point of Beginning; thence
