This is being done for an estimated saving of \$1895 per year. A partial award has been recommended, and the actual savings will be known at the end of a year when an additional award may be made.
Michael C. Robert	FIRE DEPARTMENT	\$60	Fire Fighter Michael Robert suggested using parts salvaged from defective audible alarms to make up new high pressure hose units.  30 of these units have been made, saving \$583 in the cost of new units.
Harry A Greason	. PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT Equipment Division	\$15	Mr. Greason, an Equipment Mechanic, designed an improved mounting for a motor guard so that maintenance on the guard is greatly reduced. The estimated net saving is \$147 per year.
Louis W. Bahr	PARK & RECREATION DEPT. Park Division	\$15	Mr. Bahr, a Utility Worker I, suggested that ramps be provided at three points over the curbing at Presidio Park so mowers and sweepers can be more easily moved onto the lawns. This has been done in one location and may be in the others. It will make the operation safer and faster.
Wilfred L. Wart	WATER UTILITIES DEPT.	\$10	An improved piping system for chlorine gas supply to the evaporator was proposed to be used when there is a power failure or an equipment malfunction. These rarely occur, but the system is safer and easily changed.
Larry S. Atanasoff	PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT Equipment Division	\$10	As suggested by this Stock Clerk, four storage cabinets have been provided for parts from or for equipment being repaired. This will make them more readily found when needed and prevent some loss.
