

RESOLUTION NO. 209989 FEB 26 1974

WHEREAS, the Filipino-American community is the third largest minority group in San Diego County; and

WHEREAS, the Philippine-American Community of San Diego County, Inc., has been in existence since 1959 under the name of Filipino Community Association of San Diego County, and later duly incorporated under the laws of the State of California on July 11, 1970; and

WHEREAS, the specific and primary purpose of the corporation is to promote the social, economic, educational and cultural interest of the Philippine-American born Filipinos in San Diego County; and

WHEREAS, in the pursuit of this purpose a principal objective is the promotion of better understanding and friendly relations with other people and races, and which is being accomplished by representations in the House of Pacific Relations, through the House of the Philippines, Human Relations Commission, Mexican-American Advisory Committee, Asian Pacific Congress, State Coordinating Conference Committee in Sacramento, and other important bodies; and


WHEREAS, the Philippine-American Community of San Diego County, Inc., has played, and is continuing to do so, a leading role in community movements, such as the celebration

of June 12, Philippine Independence Day; July 3rd, Philippine-American Friendship Day; December 30, Rizal; 200th Anniversary celebration of The City of San Diego through the presentation of the cultural program "Philippine Fiesta" on September 7, 1969; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the City Council proclaims June 12, 1974 as Philippine Independence Day, and July 3 as Philippine-American Friendship Day; donates the Concourse Plaza for this purpose, and urges the citizens of the City of San Diego to participate.
