WHEREAS, the Permanent Rules of the Council provide that a Committee Consultant from the Councilmanic Administration Department (02.09), Legislative Analyst Activity (02.11) shall be assigned to each standing committee other than the Rules Committee to provide staff assistance to the committee; and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with this provision at the least possible cost to the City, it is the intention of the City Council to delete from the Fiscal Year 1975 budget 1.0 Accountant position from the City Auditor's Department, 1.0 Associate Planner position from the Planning Department, and 1.0 Associate Personnel Analyst from the Personnel Department, and to add 3.0 Administrative Assistant positions to the Councilmanic Administration Department; and

WHEREAS, the Permanent Rules of the Council provide that a Committee Consultant shall be assigned to the Rules Committee from the Office of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the City Council to add 1.0 Principal Administrative Analyst position to the Mayor's Department; and

WHEREAS, the Permanent Rules of the Council provide that the City Clerk or his designee shall keep a complete record of the meetings and actions taken by the committees; and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with this provision at the least possible cost to the City, it is the intention of the City Council to add to the Fiscal Year 1975 budget 1.0 Intermediate Stenographer position to the City Clerk's Department; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide the Legislative Analyst

Consultant with one regularly City-employed professional staff

member to directly assist him with his assigned duties, it is the

intention of the City Council to add 1.0 Administrative Trainee

(Research Analyst) position to the Legislative Analyst Activity

of the Councilmanic Administration Department; and

WHEREAS, it will be helpful to the effective commencement of the committee system for staff members to be transferred or added on a limited basis as part of the committee reorganization as soon after February 28, 1974, as possible; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable to transfer monies to accommodate the objective of such limited transfer of personnel; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the City Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized to transfer \$27,917 between departments of the General Fund (100) as follows:
