
RESOLUTION NO. 210170 MAR 1 9 1974

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO REQUESTING THE CONSOLIDATION OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON JUNE 4, 1974 WITH THE STATEWIDE PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DATE.

WHEREAS, this Council intends to call a special municipal election to be held on June 4, 1974, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of the City two propositions as set forth in this resolution to amend the Charter of The City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby requested to consolidate the special municipal election to be held in the City of San Diego on June 4, 1974, with the Statewide Primary Election to be held on the same date, for the purpose of amending the Charter of The City of San Diego.
- 2. The forms of the two propositions to be voted upon at this special municipal election and as they are to appear on the ballot are as follows:



be a retired City employee?



Page # Revised 3/19/74 Each of the propositions shall be designated on the ballot by a letter printed on the left margin of the square containing the description of the measure as provided in Section 10231 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

- 3. The Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of this special municipal election and is requested to conduct the elections in all respects as if there were only one election using only one form of ballot.
- 4. The Board of Supervisors is hereby requested to issue to all officers of the County charged with duties pertaining to the Statewide Primary Election, instructions to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of the consolidated election.
- 5. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and the Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego.
