

RESOLUTION NO. 210265

Adopted on APR 2 - 1974

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Bernard J. Harding	WATER UTILITIES DEPARTMENT	\$500	Mr. Harding is an Equipment Repairman in the meter shop. Some time ago he observed that water meters used on construction projects receive severe use. He felt there should be a charge for the use of the meter as well as for the water. This has been done since last August, and the revenue to the City is expected to be \$5,000 in the first year.
Susan J. Holloway	LIBRARY	\$115	It has been a policy that the public must check all packages and material carried into Central Library. Ms. Holloway, an Intermediate Typist, observed that this was a time-consuming process that served no useful purpose. After a trial it was concluded the practice could be stopped. This saves an estimated \$1140 per year.
George Ikeda	PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT Buildings Division	\$110	George Ikeda is a Carpenter. He noted that there were frequent set-ups required to shape curves on wood strips in the shop. He suggested that an obsolete machine be used for this operation as it had been replaced for other purposes. This has been done, and eliminates \$1100 per year in set-up costs.
William K. Quiett	CITY CLERK	\$100	Bill Quiett is a Messenger for the City Clerk, and handles material into and out of the Record Center. He was concerned with the number of cartons for records that became damaged, and were also unsafe to handle in and out of the shelving. After experimenting with various tapes and patterns, he devised a way to reinforce the cartons so they will last much longer and be safe to handle. The net saving in the cost of cartons is nearly \$900 per year. Credit was given for improved safety too.
