John W. McFadden	PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT Equipment Division	\$95	John McFadden is a Motive Service Technician. He became concerned with the cost of replacement oil and fuel filters for certain engines. He found and suggested a source of less expensive filters. This will save an estimated \$931 per year.
Rodney G. Stone Dale T. Farlow	PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT Equipment Division	\$195	About a year ago, these two Welders were given a \$525 award for suggesting a way to reduce maintenance of packer trucks. It has been found that actual savings for the year warrant an additional \$195 award.
Thomas L. Miller	PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT Equipment Division	\$90	Mr. Miller suggested a way to rebuild sweeper broom segments instead of scrapping them. It has been found that this has saved about \$900 more than was expected. An additional \$90 is due.
Barbara L. Hawkins	POLICE DEPARTMENT	\$90	Ms. Hawkins is an Intermediate Steno- grapher. She proposed a time-saving change in the routine for responding to job inquiries. This suggestion led to a further saving by Personnel taking over the handling of inquiries. Over \$900 is saved in the Police Department each year.
Carl E. Fowler	PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT Equipment Division	\$90	Equipment Serviceman Fowler proposed rear tires on all new trucks with tandem wheels be replaced with recaps. The new tires would then be used on front wheels of any trucks needing them. This results in greater economy, estimated to amount to \$1800 per year. An initial award of \$90 is recommended, as the balance can be determined after a year.
