

RESOLUTION NO. 210290

Adopted on APR 2 1974

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Avery B. Cawthorn	PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT Communications Division	\$90	Ms. Cawthorn, an Intermediate Typist, made an extensive study of the routine for handling service records for maintenance on radios, and proposed several improvements. It is estimated this will save nearly \$900 per year in clerical cost.
James W. English	FIRE DEPARTMENT	\$80	Fire Fighter English felt that the test running time for emergency motor-generator sets was excessive. He proposed cutting the time to one-sixth the established time. This has been done for a saving of gasoline, oil, maintenance and wear on these units, amounting to \$800 per year
John H. Vaughn	FIRE DEPARTMENT	\$55	Fire Engineer Vaughn became concerned with the number of nozzles that became damaged and had to be scrapped. Also when they fail, they whip wildly and are a hazard. He designed a modification that prevents failure of these costly nozzles. \$465 a year is saved, and credit is given for increased safety.
Clifford M. Antijuntti	PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT Buildings Division	\$50	Each year thousands of dollars worth of costly sprinkler heads are stolen from City parks. Mr. Antijuntti, a Plumber, designed a clamp for the base of sprinkler heads that makes stealing them more difficult. It is hoped this will reduce the losses.
Thomas F. Weiks	PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT Equipment Division	\$80	Mr. Weiks, a Welder, designed a replacement water tank for sweepers that greatly simplifies maintenance when original tanks rust out. It is estimated that a net saving of \$802 per year will be made.
