


RESOLUTION No. 210300

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the offer of Valley Crest Nursery is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract for the purchase of ONE (1) EACH ATLAS CEDAR TREE (*Cedrus Atlantica*) for a total cost of \$1,900.00; terms net 30 days plus sales tax.
2. That the expenditure of \$2,014.00 is hereby authorized out of Park and Recreation Bond Funds (Fund No. 725) of the City of San Diego solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for ONE (1) EACH ATLAS CEDAR TREE in the City of San Diego and related costs.
