That in the event the proposed proceedings described above fail to materialize or are abandoned before an assessment has been levied and collected, the City shall be liable for payment for services and costs incurred in said employment in an amount not to exceed \$2,700 in accordance with the terms and conditions of said letter of March 6, 1974.

That the expenditure of not to exceed \$2,700 from Environmental Growth Fund 2505 is hereby authorized in the event the proposed district fails to materialize or is abandoned before assessments have been levied and collected.
