That in the event the proposed proceedings described above fail to materialize or are abandoned before assessments have been levied and collected, the City shall be liable for payment for services and costs incurred in said employment in an amount not to exceed \$17,250 in accordance with the terms and conditions of said letter of March 4, 1974.

That the expenditure of not to exceed \$17,250 from Environmental Growth Fund 2505 is hereby authorized in the event the proposed districts fail to materialize or are abandoned before assessments have been levied and collected.
