

RESOLUTION NO. 210397

PAVING AND OTHERWISE IMPROVING THE ALLEY,
BLOCK 23, KENSINGTON PARK; AND THE ALLEY,
BLOCK 24, SUNSET CLIFFS.

WHEREAS, the hearings provided for in Resolution of Intention No. 210066, as amended by Resolution No. 210396, pertaining to the alley, Block 23, Kensington Park and the alley, Block 24, Sunset Cliffs, have been held at the time and place fixed, and all continuances, if any, were duly made and ordered; and


WHEREAS, at said hearings all persons desiring to be heard were fully heard and all oral and written protests and objections, if any, were fully considered and this Council gave all persons present an opportunity to hear and be heard in respect to the proposed improvements; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. Written protest or objection against the proposed improvements pertaining to the alley, Block 23, Kensington Park and the alley, Block 24, Sunset Cliffs, have not been made by the owners of more than one-half of the area included within the assessment district or of the area of property to be assessed. Each and all oral and written protests and objections, if any, made or filed in the matter are hereby overruled and denied.

2. The proposed improvements within the limits mentioned in Resolution of Intention No. 210066, as amended by Resolution No. 210396, pertaining to the alley, Block 23, Kensington Park and the alley, Block 24, Sunset Cliffs, are hereby determined to be feasible and that the lands to be assessed therefor will be able to carry the burden of such proposed assessment, and that the public convenience and necessity require the proposed improvements, and that the Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931 shall not apply.
