WHEREAS, HEW has informed the County that upon payment of \$750, HEW will execute a consent instrument to allow the County of San Diego to convey an easement for right-of-way purposes to The City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the expenditure of \$825.00 from Gas Tax Fund 220 for the acquisition and related costs of the above described right-of-way, is hereby authorized.
