

RESOLUTION NO. 210460Adopted on APR 25 1974

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Kathryn E. Nielsen	POLICE DEPARTMENT	\$75	Ms. Nielsen, a Senior Typist in the Records Division, suggested a multiple, self-inking rubber stamp to replace hand printing the file jackets with crime classifications. This has saved clerical time estimated to amount to \$753 per year.
Harry A. Greason	PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT Equipment Division	\$70	Mr. Greason is an Equipment Mechanic in the Equipment Division. He designed a replacement guard for the auxiliary motors on packer trucks. This is expected to save \$703 per year in maintenance formerly required with the original guards.
Herbert E. Michaels	PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT Buildings Division	\$60	Mr. Michaels, a Refrigeration Mechanic, proposed using the emergency chiller in C.O.B. instead of the main chiller when the building is closed. This has been done for a saving of \$616 per year in electrical energy.
Joseph A Pironello	FIRE DEPARTMENT	\$25	Fire Engineer Joe Pironello designed and made an instructional chart on how to make Fire Incident Reports which are rather complicated. This has been done, and has proven very helpful at each fire station.
L. James Graham, Sr.	CITY ATTORNEY	\$20	Mr. Graham, a Senior Typist in the Attorney's Office, suggested reducing the wattage in in particular group of lights that had not been under consideration. This has been done to save \$204 worth of electricity per year.
Charles E. Kinnel	FIRE DEPARTMENT	\$10	Fire Engineer Kinnel noted a hazard existed from unsupported engine hoods. He designed a latch that will insure the hoods not dropping and injuring men working on the engines.
