

RESOLUTION NO. 210525 MAY 2 1974

WHEREAS, as a result of the large amount of Federal real property and military installations in the San Diego area, the San Diego City Schools provide educational services to an inordinately great number of federally connected children; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Impact Aid Program was established to provide continuing financial assistance to local school districts for the burden imposed by tax exemption of Federal real property and the presence of eligible federally connected children; and

WHEREAS, in a recent message on education to Congress, President Nixon proposed a phasing out of the Federal Impact Aid Program for school districts; and

WHEREAS, local school districts presently carry a significant budgetary burden as a result of providing educational services to federally connected children in that program proposed to be phased out; and

WHEREAS, if the President's proposal for reducing funding of the program is approved by Congress, the effect would be catastrophic on the San Diego City Schools in that the district would lose approximately three and a half million dollars in the coming year in Impact Aid; and

WHEREAS, if such diminution in income continued, San Diego City Schools would be required to increase the tax burden on

the local property owners or reduce the quality of education now provided; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That this Council, for and on behalf of the citizens of the City of San Diego, hereby publicly expresses its opposition to the proposed phase out of the Federal Impact Aid Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this City Council, for and on behalf of the citizens of the City of San Diego, urges the San Diego congressional delegation to oppose vigorously this proposed phase out of the Federal Impact Aid Program.
