RESOLUTION NO. 210526 MAY 2 1974

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council is concerned about the availability of educational facilities and the quality of the educational program offered to the citizens of San Diego by the public school system; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified School District is facing a critical need for educational facilities and equipment to provide a quality program of education for more than 125,000 students; and

WHEREAS, capital funding for these facilities and equipment needs has not been available to the school district since passage of a bond issue in 1966; and

WHEREAS, the facilities and equipment needs of the school district have increased during the past six (6) years to such a degree that the educational program standards for the public school students of San Diego is threatened; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the San Diego Unified School District, after months of staff and community-involved study has placed on the June 4, 1974 State Primary Election Ballot three (3) finance measures to meet these critical facilities and equipment needs; and


WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified School District, the second largest in the State of California, is located within the boundaries of the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the quality of the public school facilities and educational program are an integral part of the total community services which are essential to the economic, social, and political growth of this City in Motion and to the quality of life in San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of The City of San Diego does hereby endorse Propositions X, Y, and Z which have been placed on the June 4, 1974 State Primary Election Ballot for the purpose of providing essential funds to meet the critical facilities and equipment needs of the San Diego Unified School District, and urges all citizens to support these ballot measures.
