This Council hereby requests that the Planning Commission and the Planning Department report to the Council on the following factors when processing requests for new residential zoning within the I-15 Corridor.

- 1. Will the rate and timing of production of the dwelling units allowable under this new residential zoning request be compatible with the projected rate of total growth in the Corridor as determined by improvements in traffic capacity and is this residential production rate assured?
- 2. Is the new residential zoning request offset by the withholding of a comparable number of dwelling units from the current inventory within the particular community?
- 3. Is the new residential zoning within a community which has an approved phased growth plan which assures a construction rate of residential dwelling units?
- 4. Should the new residential zoning request be approved before Council has adopted coordinated phased growth plans for the various City communities?
- 5. What specific provisions are being taken to provide educational facilities within this rezoning within the I-15 Corridor?
