

RESOLUTION NO. 210615 MAY 16 1974


WHEREAS, three substandard unsalable residences purchased for the Landis Street widening were demolished at a cost of \$989 in order to clear the right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, funds in the Capital Improvements Program were not adequate to cover this expense and \$944.76 was utilized from the Property Department's 245 Revolving Fund, which should be reimbursed; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the expenditure of \$944.76 from Gas Tax Fund 220 for expenses incurred for Landis Street be and the same is hereby authorized, supplementing Resolution No. 199637 in said amount.
